

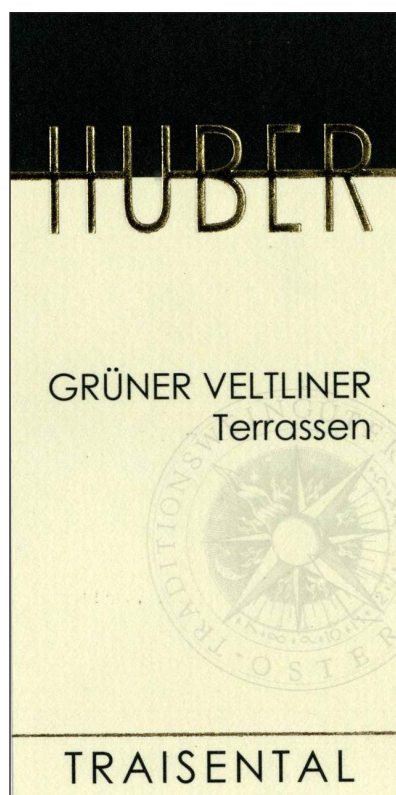

TERROIR: The limestone mix soil found in the Traisental area produces outstanding Veltliner and Rieslings with unmistakable character and distinction. The clarity and minerality of the wines are an expression of the climate and the vineyards from which they originated. Climatically, the region is very similar to that of the Burgund - Reichersdorf and lies along the same latitude as Beaune. The area sees cool nights and warm days.
